1 PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Polymer sealer containing polyurethane for the care treatment of resilient floors in areas where the application of a hard sealer is not possible. Also suitable for refreshing floors with a PU factory finish. Ideally suitable for floors in domestic environments. Matt appearance.

- Protects the floor by creating an elastic, anti-slip, mat film.
- Dirt adhesion is reduced and routine cleaning is facilitated.
- Suitable for renovating care-film in a high speed process.
- Now even better matt finish for a natural look.
- Fulfils DIN Norm 18031 for sport floors.

2 AREAS OF APPLICATION

Vinyl and linoleum floors. Use on rubber floors is possible only under certain circumstances and should be checked before use.

3 METHOD OF APPLICATION

Initial Protection: 1) First thoroughly clean the floor with Clean and Strip. 2) Shake Floor Mat well and apply undiluted in a thin, even flm using the Polish Applicator System or a non-felting wiper mop. 3) Allow the floor surface to dry overnight before it is used. 4) For some floor coverings, no care treatment is recommended. Please refer to the care instructions for the floor covering. Daily Cleaning: Add 1 graduation = 50 ml Floor Mat to a bucket (8-10 litres) of water. Turn off under-floor central heating before commencing work. Note: When applying the product undiluted, avoid strong sunlight and drafts. Turn off under-floor central heating before commencing work.

4 CONSUMPTION

Initial Protection/Refreshing: ca. 2 litres per 100 m² Daily Cleaning : about. 0,2 litres per 100 m²

5 STORAGE

Store in cool, dry conditions in well sealed receptacles. Store under lock and key and out of the reach of children.
